## **INVERLEIGH OPEN TOURNAMENT - CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- 1. Entry fees must be paid at time of entry.
- 2. The Match Committee of the Inverleigh Golf Club shall have the entire management of the tournament.
- 3. All players must produce proof of exact G.A. handicap when called upon. Maximum handicaps are 35 for men and 45 for ladies. For 27 holes events a player's starting handicap will apply for the entire event.
- 4. Players must be prepared when called upon to do so and shall report to the starter at least 30 minutes prior to the advertised hit off time.
- 5. Entries are restricted to amateurs who are members of G.A., or of Golf Clubs registered with such State or Overseas Associations as are affiliate with the G.V. and the Committee shall have the right to refuse entry to any person without being requested to give any reason for such refusal. Golf pass not accepted.
- 6. Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the course over which the competition takes place. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Committee in charge of the competition, whose decision shall be final. Provided however, that the Committee, if in doubt shall have the right to refer any such dispute to G.A. whose decision shall then be final.
- 7. Any dispute or protest shall be made to the Committee in writing, within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the days play.
- 8. The Match Committee may, in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, shorten, postpone or abandon any event/grades
- 9. Ties: In the event of a tie in all events except the single Gross events, will be decided by Countback according to the Golf Australia Countback system. A single gross event shall be decided by a sudden-death play off. In the event of a tie in the Ladies Rose Bowl event, a countback to be applied to all members, as per the GA recommended countback system.
- 10. Entries are not transferable. No competitor may resign his or her place in the field to another player, except in team events.
- 11. No player shall be awarded more than one (1) trophy on any block entry, the exception being N.T.P.'s.
- 12. The use of ride on motorised buggies is prohibited in events 1 16, unless prior permission has been given by the Match Committee, where a medical reason/certificate has been supplied.
- 13. All visitors to Inverleigh Golf Club during the Tournament will be made honorary members of the Club.
- 14. Distance measuring devices are permitted, if a device has access to other information e.g. gradient, windspeed, temperature etc, players may **only** use the distance measuring function.
- 15. The Committee shall have the right to refuse entry to any person without being requested to give any reason for such refusal
