CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, Scotland, together with local rules in force on the course when the competition takes place. If a dispute arises at any point, it shall be decided by the Committee in charge of the competition, whose decision will be final. Entries are restricted to amateurs who are members of Clubs of Golf Victoria, Clubs affiliated with the Victorian Golf League, Golf Clubs registered with such State or Overseas Associations affiliated with or recognised by this Association. The Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal. A playoff will determine the winner if required and will commence on hole one. The Committee may, in the event of extreme weather, or for any other reason, either cancel or shorten any contest, or fix another day. Players must be prepared to play when called upon by the Committee. In every event, competitors will be drawn against each other for the day in such a manner as the Committee may arrange. No player can win more than one (1) major and one (1) minor event. Purpose built powered golf carts and buggies permitted. Distance measuring devices are permitted. A player may obtain information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a match, a player uses a device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that may affect their play (e.g. gradient, windspeed, temperature, etc) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3 for which the penalty is disqualification regardless of whether any such function is used.
