GOLDEN PUTTER – A CELEBRATED TRADITION

Established in 1980, the Golden Putter was created by Queenscliff Golf Club as a prestigious yet welcoming event celebrating women's golf and encouraging participation in competitive play. With a simple format, an inclusive spirit and a unique prize, the event quickly became a favourite fixture on the golfing calendar.

Traditionally, the winning pair was presented with a Golden Putter as a symbol of their achievement – a treasured memento recognising their success in this much-loved event.

Over the years, the Golden Putter has enjoyed generous support from valued sponsors including Dawn and Laurie Wheelan, Judy and Lorraine Golightly, Fay Neville, and Anthony Webber from Lake and Land Civil Contracting, helping ensure this special tradition continues.

Now, more than four decades on, the Golden Putter 4BBB Stableford Pairs Event remains one of the most anticipated events for women golfers at Queenscliff Golf Club. The tradition continues, with a modern twist – the winning pair will each receive their very own “Golden” Putter, now transformed into a fully functional club ready to be put straight into play.

A piece of history, a memorable prize, and plenty to play for.

Conditions of Play

Four Ball Better Ball (4BBB) Stableford: Teams of two players compete, with the best score from each team being recorded for each hole. Players with a recognised GA handicap are eligible to compete - maximum handicap 45.

General Rules

- Team Composition: Each team consists of two players.
- Scoring Format: The game is played as Stableford.
- Best Ball Scoring: On each hole, both team members play their own ball. The lower of the two scores is recorded as the team score for that hole.

Conditions of Entry

- Entry fee must be paid at the time of entry. A 1.1% credit card surcharge applies.
- Teams can consist of players from any Club.
- All financial playing members of affiliated clubs with an officially recognised GA handicap are eligible to compete. It is each player's responsibility to ascertain their correct handicap.
- Handicap limit of 45 applies on the day of competition.
- The match committee will make all arrangements and have full power to alter or create any variations in the program or order of play.
- The competition shall be played according to the rules of golf adopted by The Royal and Ancient Club of St Andrews, Scotland, together with any local rules in force.
- In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided on a countback according to the conditions set out by Golf Australia.
- The match committee will deal with any written protest that must be lodged at the club by 3:00 pm on the day of the competition. The decision of the match committee will be final.
- No player may receive more than one trophy. (Not including nearest the pins).
- As Queenscliff Golf Club is located on Department of Defence land, all persons must present a Photo ID at the security checkpoint before crossing the bridge to Swan Island. Only original documents are accepted, no photocopies, photographs or scans. Official digital records (e.g., VicRoads digital license) may also be used. Note: Please do not stop or take photos while crossing the bridge or causeway, and obey all road signs.
